THE EXHIBITION

This exhibition aims at presenting a global overview of Mathias TUSIIME's work, displaying different techniques (handmade or industrial papers, canvas). His artwork deals mainly with the daily life, with light scenes like in *Party Time* or *Happy Hour* but also with more serious topics like in the set called *Child Labour* or in *I will survive*. Besides, the reference to environment is pervasive in his work, whether in his technique (using recycled materials) or in the themes of the paintings (*Keep it clean, Nature & Beauty...*)



BIOGRAPHY OF THE ARTIST



Mathias TUSIIME is a self-taught artist from Bushenyi who converts waste like discarded paint, paper and sugar cane pulp into bright cheerful artworks.



He is known both locally and internationally and exhibited his work in the USA, in Denmark, in the Netherlands and in many places in Uganda (Makerere University, Kampala Gallery).
